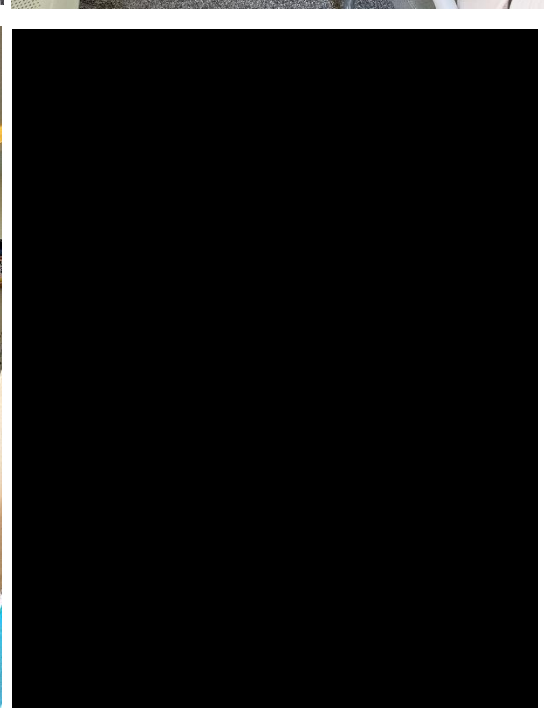
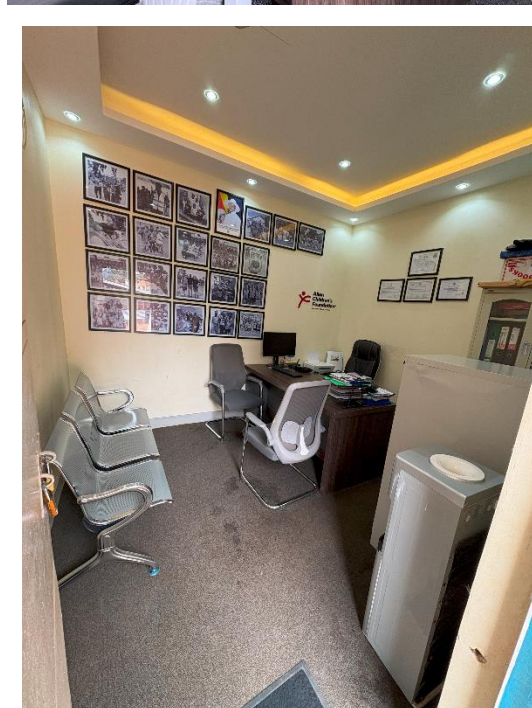
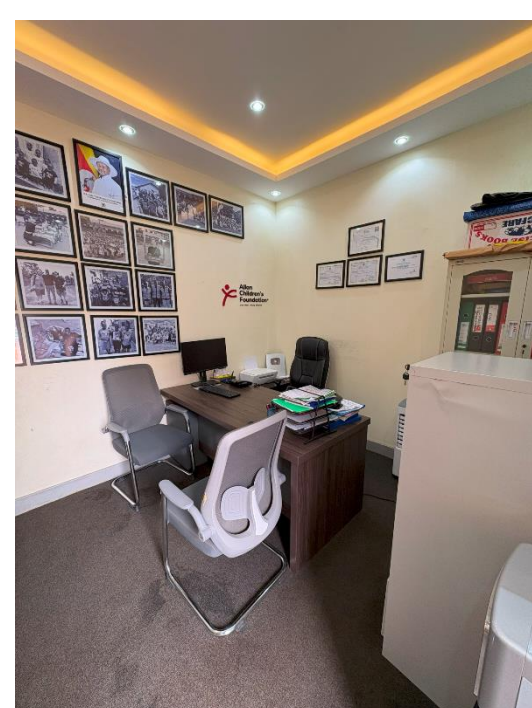

# EDUCATION

In 2025, the foundation successfully blessed over 1,000 Children in different parts of the country with scholastic materials for learners to start school and the foundation has committed itself to providing scholastic materials to children who need it most including the registered Children of the foundation every school term.

The Allan Children's Foundation has 220 registered Children who receives all the support including payment of school fees/tuition every school term. The parents always come at our office every school term to collect their children's school tuition and their always bring receipts from schools for proof of payment and accountability. "



## School meals and nutrition for better performance

Children under our care are also provided with nutritious meals, which has greatly contributed to improved school attendance and academic performance. Many schools in our partner communities are unable to provide lunch due to limited funding; therefore, the Foundation stepped providing in food and drinks. This initiative has enhanced the wellbeing of learners, increased attendance, and supported better performance, especially in candidate classes after national examinations.



## Health and Wellbeing

At Allan Children’s Foundation, we believe that good health is the foundation of a bright future. Every day, our team works tirelessly to ensure that vulnerable children, single mothers, elderly people, and struggling families have access to essential healthcare, medical checkups, and wellness support. From routine health screenings and vaccinations to providing medicines and hygiene education, we leave no stone unturned in safeguarding the wellbeing of those we serve.

Our dedication extends beyond our headquarters in Kampala. Through community outreaches in remote areas, we reach families who otherwise have little access to medical care, delivering health services to over 1,000 people — children and adults alike. These efforts reflect the hard work, compassion, and relentless commitment of our staff and volunteers, who go above and beyond to ensure that every individual not only survives but thrives.

At Allan Children’s Foundation, nurturing health and wellbeing is more than a program — it is a promise to empower lives, restore hope, and build stronger, healthier communities.

Improving the quality of life for children through healthcare and nutrition support. The Foundation prioritizes the health of children, ensuring access to medical services, proper nutrition, and clothing. In 2025, over 100 Children including little Ibrahim benefited from dental and medical assistance.

The Foundation further enhanced children's wellbeing by providing clothing and individualized care support, including furniture, medication, and upkeep. These interventions have helped vulnerable children live healthier, more dignified lives.

## BIRTHDAYS AND JOY AT ALLAN CHILDREN'S FOUNDATION

At Allan Children's Foundation, we believe that every child deserves to feel special, loved, and celebrated. That's why we make it a point to celebrate the birthdays of all 220 registered children in our organization. Every month, we come together to honor our children's birthdays, giving each child a memorable birthday party complete with cake, decorations, games, and a special birthday present.

These celebrations are more than just parties, they are moments of joy, belonging, and affirmation for our children. For many, it may be the only time in the year they experience a personal celebration, surrounded by friends and family-like support. Seeing the smiles on their faces, the laughter, and the excitement reminds us of the profound impact of love and attention on a child's wellbeing.

By celebrating birthdays, Allan Children's Foundation not only brings happiness to our children but also nurtures their self-esteem, sense of identity, and emotional growth. It teaches them that they are valued, cherished, and deserving of joy, laying the foundation for confident, hopeful, and resilient futures.

# Improving nutrition outcomes

Through regular provision of meals, the Foundation has not only supported growth and development but also improved energy and classroom concentration among children.

Caregivers and staff observed notable improvements in school attendance and participation as a result of this intervention.



## Child Protection and Welfare

To promote children's joy, belonging, and psychosocial wellbeing, the foundation organized the annual Christmas Party, which brought together 800 people including 220 registered children in our organization, parents, community leaders and children. During that day, every children got a Christmas gift and parents went back home with food items to help them during the Christmas holiday.



Additional donations were distributed to children, while smaller initiatives such as Mothers Day celebrations and fellowships fostered family and community bonding. “

## Community Engagement and Sanitation

Raising awareness on hygiene, sanitation, and child protection. The Foundation worked directly with the community to promote better hygiene, fight domestic violence, and foster stronger child protection systems. In 2025, community outreaches in Kampala, Wakiso, Mityana & Kiboga District, reaching out to families and schools with messages on sanitation, hygiene improvement, and child safety. “

To maintain a safe and healthy environment for children under our care, the Foundation also ensured regular sanitation activities, including toilet emptying and office maintenance, alongside employing domestic support staff. These activities not only ensured the health and safety of children but also served as a model of good hygiene practices for surrounding communities.



# Success Stories of Change

## A Moment That Proves Humanity Still Exists

Meet Mama Immaculate, a courageous single mother of two beautiful daughters, one of them named Marceline. For years, she faced unimaginable challenges. Every day was a battle to provide even the basics for her family. Her small business barely earned \$3 a day, and some nights she went to bed worrying whether her children would have enough to eat the next morning.

Mama Immaculate's daughters are registered under Allan Children's Foundation, where they receive education support, medical care, clothing, shoes, daily meals, and all the basic needs every child deserves. Knowing her children were cared for gave her hope, but she still longed for the independence to provide for them herself — to break free from the constant struggle and create a stable future.

Today, that hope became reality. In just 6 hours, we helped transform Mama Immaculate's small business from struggling to thriving — increasing her daily income from \$3 to \$20. We didn't just offer guidance; we gave her a large supply of stock and added new items to her business, including ingredients like tomatoes, onions, carrots, green peppers, green bananas (Matooke), Irish potatoes, and more. On top of that, we provided cash support to ensure she could run her business without worry and focus entirely on growth.

This transformation is about much more than money. It is about dignity, independence, and the promise of a brighter future. Now, Mama Immaculate can confidently care for her daughters, keep them in school, and continue building a life she once only dreamed of.

At Allan Children's Foundation, we believe that empowering a mother uplift an entire generation. Mama Immaculate's journey proves it — one woman, one moment, a whole new beginning.



# A Success Story

## Little Ibrahim's Journey with Allan Children's Foundation

Little Ibrahim is a vibrant 4-year-old boy who was born with cerebral palsy. He lives with his courageous single mother, Sulayina, in a small community near where the Allan Children's Foundation operates. Ibrahim's journey has not been an easy one. When he was born, his condition was severe, and his mother struggled to meet his medical and basic needs. The situation was so critical that Ibrahim's life was at risk.

Two years ago, Allan Kato, President of the Allan Children's Foundation, was contacted by Sulayina, who bravely shared her struggles and her son's condition. Upon hearing Ibrahim's story, Allan and the team knew they had to step in. From that moment, the organization began supporting Ibrahim and his mother from scratch. At the time, Ibrahim was just 2 years old.

The Foundation immediately mobilized resources and shared Ibrahim's story with its social media family. The response was overwhelming—people from all over the world wanted to help. With their support, the Foundation ensured Ibrahim received treatments from the best hospitals, covering all medical expenses. Professional physical therapists were brought in to work with him, helping him gain strength and mobility despite his condition.

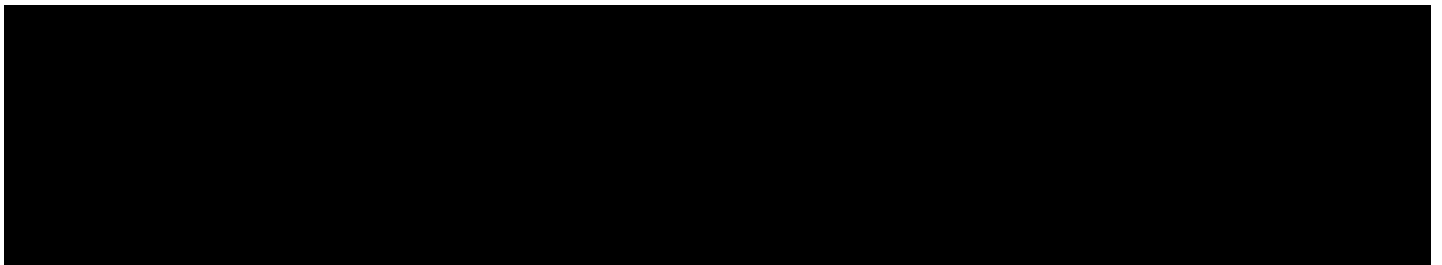
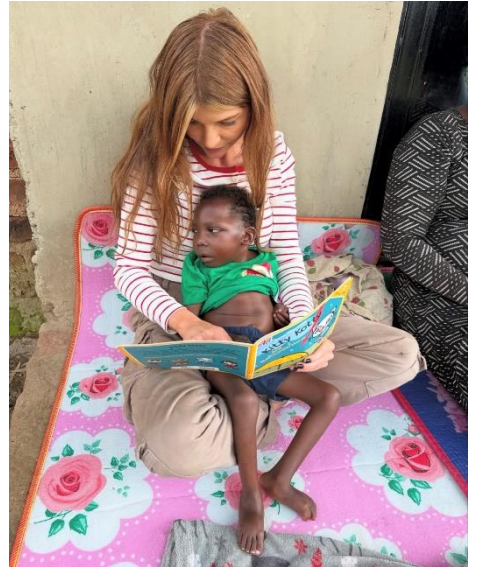
Beyond medical care, the organization addressed the family's living situation. Sulayina had a house deep in the village that lacked basic necessities. The Foundation renovated the house, providing electricity, running water, and painting it, creating a safe and comfortable home for both mother and child.

Marialye, a volunteer from Canada, connected with Ibrahim immediately and became a constant presence in his life. With the organization's support, she stayed with Ibrahim and Sulayina, bringing love, care, and joy to their days. Their bond captured hearts globally through videos shared on the Foundation's social media, inspiring countless people with their story of hope and resilience.

Over the past three years, Ibrahim has received all the equipment a child with cerebral palsy needs, including wheelchairs and other essential tools to improve his quality of life. Every month, he visits the hospital, and the Foundation ensures that all his medical needs are met. Every year, his birthday is celebrated with love and joy, marking milestones in his incredible journey.

For Ibrahim and Sulayina, the support from the Allan Children's Foundation has been life-changing. They went from struggling to survive to living with dignity, comfort, and hope for the future. Today, Ibrahim is thriving, receiving the care he deserves, and touching lives around the world with his resilience and spirit.

Ibrahim's journey is a powerful reminder of the difference that love, compassion, and community support can make. His life is celebrated not just by his family, but by everyone whose heart he has touched.

## Financial Overview (12 Months)

This report presents the financial overview of the Foundation for the 12-month period, covering revenue, operating expenses, program allocations, and priorities.

### 1. Revenue

The total revenue for the period was UGX 123,596,421, received entirely through donations from partners, well-wishers, and community supporters.

### 2. Operating Expenses

The Foundation spent UGX 111,628,671 on operating programs and support services, representing 90.3% of the total revenue. The remaining 9.7% (UGX 11,967,750) was retained to support administrative sustainability and future programming.

### 3. Program Areas

Education (37.5%) - UGX 41,853,000

Health & Wellbeing (37.0%) - UGX 41,299,820

Child Protection & Welfare (10.1%) - UGX 11,293,601

Community Engagement & Outreach (5.9%) - UGX 6,635,000

Governance & Administration (9.5%) - UGX 10,547,250

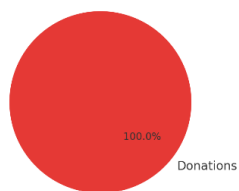
### 4. Program Priorities

- 37.5% invested in education and scholastic support.
- 37.0% invested in health, nutrition, and basic needs.
- 10.1% directed towards child protection and welfare.
- 5.9% directed to community outreach and sanitation.
- 9.5% spent on governance and administrative costs.

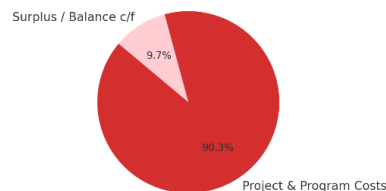
## Financial Overview Charts

Financial Overview - 12 Months

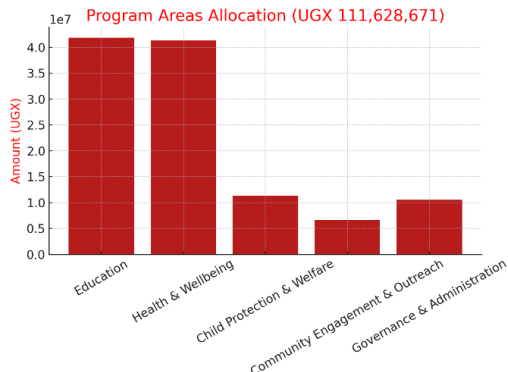
Revenue Sources (UGX 123,596,421)

## FUTURE PLANS

### OF ALLAN CHILDREN’S FOUNDATION

At Allan Children’s Foundation, our mission is to create lasting change in the lives of vulnerable children and families. While we have already made great strides in providing education, healthcare, nutrition, and empowerment, our vision for the future is even greater.

#### 1. Expansion of Education Support

- Enroll more children into our education program so no child is left behind.
- Build or partner with schools to ensure children in rural and underserved communities can access quality education.
- Provide vocational training and skill development for older children to prepare them for future employment and independence.

#### 2. Comprehensive Healthcare Access

- Establish a community health center dedicated to children and families under our care.
- Increase access to regular checkups, vaccinations, emergency treatment, and specialized care for children with chronic conditions.
- Expand mental health and counseling support for children and mothers dealing with trauma, loss, or poverty-related stress.

#### 3. Nutrition & Food Security

- Develop community farms and food programs to ensure every child and family has access to nutritious meals.
- Expand food distribution programs to reach more families during crises.
- Train families in modern farming techniques so they can sustainably provide for themselves.

#### 4. Women & Family Empowerment

- Support more single mothers like Mama Immaculate by helping them start or grow small businesses.
- Provide financial literacy and entrepreneurship training for families to become self-reliant.
- Create community savings groups to strengthen family incomes and resilience.

## 5. Infrastructure & Safe Spaces for Children

- Build a children’s resource center that provides education support, recreation, counseling, and mentorship under one roof.
- Establish safe shelters for children at risk of abuse, abandonment, or extreme poverty.
- Create libraries, computer labs, and creative spaces to nurture talent and innovation among children.

## 6. Sustainability & Growth

- Partner with local and international organizations to scale up our impact.
- Invest in renewable energy and water projects to serve both the Foundation and the wider community.
- Develop long-term funding strategies to ensure consistent support for all registered children.

Our ultimate vision is a world where every child has the freedom to dream, the tools to achieve, and the support to thrive. By empowering children and their families today, we are building stronger communities and shaping a brighter tomorrow.
